Dear Smurf Collectors,

Hopefully, everyone has had a pleasant Summer and a successful season of searching through Flea Markets and Garage Sales for those elusive Smurf items on your want lists.

The latest word we received from Irwin Toys is, "The remainder of the Smurf Product Line will be available in September." It is reported that the initial sales of the collectible figurines has been very good. As the holiday buying season begins, we are sure the remainder of their Smurf line will be available. Please keep us posted on what you see in your area. Thank you.

In our last Newsletter we discussed our belief that Irwin Toys has never held a license to produce Smurf Products previously. It has now been confirmed, however, that they did, back in 1983; Irwin Toys was listed by Wallace Berrie as a licensed Smurf Producer of Smurf toys. It is unclear, at this point, exactly what toys they produced under their license. If anyone has any information they would like to share, please write the Club. We would like to call on our Canadian members to search through their collections and see if they have any items produced by Irwin Toys. Our research continues.

We have learned that 1996 marks the Irwin Toys 70th year of operation. The company was started by Samuel B. Irwin in a garage. The Irwin company has grown into a 100 million dollar company marketing products in over 50 countries around the world. It has only been a few years that they have entered the U.S. market with their product lines. For the record, **Toy Island** is one of their "associates" producing Smurf products.

Last year, included in our Club survey, was a request for our members to participate in sending their ideas for future Smurf figurines they would like to see produced by Schleich. This proved to be an overwhelming success and loads of fun for all.

Thanks also to your publication I also now know that the Smurfette marked Bully, that was unlike the other Smurfettes, is the flirting Smurfette. I had wondered just where she fit in as I could not find any pictures that looked exactly like her. Mystery solved!


### Collectors Comments.....

Logo from the "Smurf the World" foundation




### SPECIAL EVENTS






## SPECIAL EUROPEAN SMURF PROMOTIONS

The Windmill (top left) is blue and white with Smurf Miller holding a sack of wheat. Remember all of Ferrero's little figurines are unique!

The Hammock (top center) hangs from two tress and mounts on a base. The figurine lies on his back in the hammock and he is holding a bottle of pop.

The Tower (top right) is white with yellow and red details. Stickers are applied featuring more details. The figurine is Ferrero's version of the Bricklayer.

The Mushroom House (bottom left) opens on hinges so that you can see the two floors inside. It has mini furnishings inside.

The Farm Tractor w/trailer (lower right) is another great item to add to a Smurf Village!

Also produced for this promotion were five different plushes. These are approximately 7" and also come in the plastic eggs. They are produced in Italy.




It has been reported to us that Ferrero will be producing two different Smurf sets for 1996-97. These, we are told, will be snap-together-Smurfs.


Once again, it is reported that many cakes had to be purchased in order to find a "Bean." It was almost, no, it was impossible, to get all ten figurines!

### SMURF REVIVAL AROUND THE WORLD



We are pleased to report that Toy Island (Irwin Toys) will be marketing most of the items we featured in our last Newsletter overseas. Their launch will appear in the Netherlands, Belgium, France, Germany and Italy.

Italy's private TV channel, Rete 4, is running Smurf episodes every night of the week at 8 P.M. They report that their adult audience is very encouraging!

The Far East reports that Asian kids enjoy the Smurfs as much as the western kids. Smurfs really have universal appeal. Burnshing Ltd. in Hong Kong has been very active in bringing Smurfs to the attention of youngsters and their parents in Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore and China.

The Sunday Hong Kong Standard got a great response when they ran English versions of Smurf comic gags; readers actually called the newspaper trying to get copies they missed.

Culturecom in China will release the entire series of Smurf books in Chinese over the next three years. The first issues are already in shops.

Kwan Kin in Hong Kong is doing a tie-in with the book release. They are producing canvas shoulder bags and briefcases featuring the new modern Smurfs.


