Welcome back to all "True Blue" fans for this our Thirteenth Year! Welcome, also, to all new members who have come on board for year thirteen.

This year, in recognition of the Smurf's 40th Anniversary, we are hoping to feature as many Smurf Products, produced exclusively for this anniversary, as possible. As of this printing, all of these products are being produced for the European market. In view of this, we ask our overseas members to please help. If you see a product with the 40th Anniversary Logo (shown below), please send us a complete description of the item with a photo. We need you all to serve as our eyes and ears around the world. Thanks in advance. "Sharing is Caring."

The 40th Anniversary Set is Jubilaumset in German.

The next issue we would like to discuss is the fact that figurines. 20449, 20450, 20451 and Super Smurf 40250, Super Smurf Playset 40623, (see Newsletter 48), are all produced in paint color variations for the 40th Anniversary Set.

We anticipate that, in years to come, this information will be very important as we are sure the Anniversary Set Smurfs will be found for sale as individual pieces. They will be classified as "RARE" because only 20,000 sets are being produced this year! By becoming familiar with these special colors now, we will find it easy to recognize the variations when we come across them "on their own" in the future.

Before we begin the color descriptions, we would like to discuss another issue. Over the years our members have written to ask that we use some sort of color chart to identify paint colors. We made a few different attempts to prepare a color chart but failed to come up with a satisfactory and workable tool.. We recently received a suggestion from one of our members that just might solve this color-description problem and, since it has an element of fun in it, we would like to give it a whirl. For a few dollars we can each purchase a BIG BOX of Crayola Crayons (96 Crayons.) Smurf paint colors will be matched to the crayon colors. As an experiment, we will put this into effect now (see below). Please let us know how you feel about this plan and whether or not we should continue with this color-description method. Thank you, in advance, for your suggestions and opinions!



Regular Series figurines

No. 20449 Lead guitar player White shoes and hat. "Cerulean" overalls with black patches on his knees. Red guitar with black details, silver strings with black details. Strap is "Sepia." Wrist bands are "Yellow/Green."

Lead Guitar player, 40th Anniversary Set. Black shoes and white hat. Silver overalls and patches. "Mauvelous" guitar with black details, silver strings with black detail. Strap is "Sepia." Wrist bands and overalls shoulder strap are "Laser Lemon."

No. 20450 Bass guitar player White shoes and hat, Black pants with white belt. Red shirt. Tan guitar with white and black details, silver strings, strap is "Sepia." Wrist band is "Yellow/Green."

Bass Guitar player, 40th Anniversary Set. Black shoes and white hat. Silver pants with white belt. "Green/Yellow" shirt. Tan guitar with white and black details, silver strings, strap is "Sepia." Wrist band is "Tickle Me Pink."

No. 20451 Singer White shoes and hat. "Sepia" pants with black belt, silver buckle. Jacket is "Atomic Tangerine," shirt is "Electric Lime." Microphone has a black base with a red top.

Singer, 40th Anniversary Set. Black shoes and white hat. Silver pants with silver belt buckle, belt is gray. Jacket is black, shirt is "Laser Lemon." Microphone has a black base with a "Thistle" top.

Super Smurf

The keyboards in No. 40250 and the 40th Anniversary Set are the same. Only the figurines are painted differently!

No. 40250 Keyboarder White shoes, hat and shirt. "Sepia" pants and sunglass lenses. Tie and Sunglasses frame are "Vivid Tangerine."

Keyboarder, 40th Anniversary Set. Black shoes and long coat. "Spring Green" shirt and sunglasses frame. Silver eyeglass lenses.

#### **Drummer Set**

The Drums in the #40623 are red plastic. The Drums in the 40th Anniversary Set are "Mauvelous." The bases for the two sets are completely different, this is obvious in the photo featured in our last Newsletter

No 40623 Drummer White shoes and hat. "Laser Lemon" plastic drum sticks. Purple pants, "Dandelion" shirt, brown wrist band.

Drummer 40th Anniversary set. Black shoes and white hat. "Laser Lemon" plastic drum sticks. Silver pants, "Laser Lemon" shirt, "Thistle" wrist band.

Special Note......There is one important color difference that is a key to remember! The Regular Series shoes are WHITE. The 40th Anniversary Series figurines shoes are BLACK!

Two other items being produced by Schleich, Germany for the Smurfs 40th Anniversary are this lovely Tote bag featuring the Musical figurines. This is a great item to carry when hunting Smurfs at Toy shows, garage sales, flea market etc. A real show stopper. This is a large tote bag measuring 16" by 19".



This year Schleich's small color pamphlet featuring the Golden 100 figurines etc. bears the 40th Anniversary Logo.

This is an update to our article with the above title that was featured in our Newsletter 42, Fall 1996.


In review, Epiphany Day is celebrated on January 6th every year in France. It is the anniversary of the coming of the Three Wise Men to honor the infant Jesus at Bethlehem. Also known as the Twelfth Day of Christmas.

One is known to eat what is called "twelfth-night cakes" in which is hidden a tiny little bean. These beans are porcelain and are hand painted.. and variations have been spotted. We are please to report that for this occasion in 1997 and 1998 Smurf Beans were produced.

The 1997 series featured all Baby Smurfs. The 1998 series featured Soccer Smurfs in Honor of the 1998 World Cup Soccer Games in France this Summer.

We have been able to verify the following Baby Smurf Beans:

Baby with a book
Baby sitting on a quarter moon.
Baby holding a teddy bear
Baby sucking thumb
Baby with ice cream pop
Baby with rattle
Baby holding sail boat
Baby with blocks
Baby stretched out on tummy
Baby mounted on a Star plaque



The Soccer Player Beans are in all different action poses. It is believed that twelve different poses were produced, but we have been unable to verify all twelve at this time. As more information is received at Club Headquarters we will keep you updated.

# McDonald's Fast Food Promotion

# United Kingdom April 3, 1998 to May 3, 1998

In Celebration of the Smurfs 40th Anniversary, McDonalds in England had a Smurf Promotion on the above dates.


In Newsletter 43, Winter 1996, we reported on a Smurf Promotion at McDonalds In Germany and the Netherlands. This promotion was in celebration of McDonald's 25th Anniversary in these two countries.

This 1998 promotion had a number of differences that we will now discuss. Ten figurines were featured. Nine of the figurines are the same as the previous promotion. One figurine is completely different.

The figurine below from the 1996 promotion, was eliminated in the 1998 promotion.



The figurine below was introduced for this 1998 promotion. He is a Smurf holding the McDonalds Happy Meal Box. The box is a bright yellow/gold with the Happy Meal Face in black and the McDonalds "M." This is a trademark owned by McDonalds Corporation.



The ten figurines in the England promotion were produced as one series, unlike the 1996 promotion that was produced in two series of five figurines each. Each figurine does bear the "M" Golden Arches emblem embossed on the back of it's hat as the previous series does. All of the figurines are painted exactly the same as the previous German and Netherlands series; no variations have been noted. Again, we remind you that most of the molds have been altered. All of the mold alterations are described in detail in our previous article in Newsletter 43, Winter 1996. (Anyone seeking this article please request ordering information with a S.A.S.E.).


The packaging for the England Series was different (see below). The figurines are in a white package that you can't see through so you don't know what you are getting. McDonalds put two little holes in the bags so, if you look, hard enough you can tell what figurine is inside.



The Happy Meal Box is used this time instead of the Happy Meal Bag used last time. The box is produced in lovely bright colors and is shaped like a mushroom. See below.



Box colors: Red, Yellow &Green Featured below is the Happy Meal Smurf cardboard hat.



Some of our collector friends from England have also mentioned that their McDonalds had Smurf Flags (on sticks) with a few different Smurfy designs. Smurf balloons were also available for this promotion, but no photos have been supplied for publication.

Last. but not least, the Meal Box used with the New Smurf McDonald figurine, produced exclusively for this promotion, is a registered Trademark.

Although they were only secondary characters at first, they quickly earned their independence by becoming highly popular.

Their first appearances were in mini-stories but when they began to appear in albums, they became genuine heroes of what is called the 8th art. Soon, the pages became too small for them. Figurines, plushes, toys, hit records and, above all, the TV show made them stars around the world.

From Canada to Australia - and in partically every country in between - the Smurfs have worked their way into several million homes.




