SMURFS STAR IN NEW GAME BOY TITLE and PLAY STATION TITLE

Due to be released in the U.S.A. in 2000

Infogrames Entertainment has signed the Smurf, the pint-size blue cartoon characters, for a new Game Boy Color game. The "SMURFS NIGHTMARE" is an adventure set in the warlock induced dreams of sleeping Smurfs. Players must break the magician's spell that has kept the Smurfs locked in a perpetual nightmare.



Another game being produced for Play Station is "The Smurfs" developed by Heliogame and published by Infogrames. This game is aimed at the younger crowd ages 4 through 7. It is divided into two sub-games.

The easier part of the game lets player slip into the oversized white shoes of Hefty Smurf. Apparently, a passing stork has dropped Baby Smurf on the unsuspecting inhabitants of Smurf Village and it is up to Hefty to keep Baby Smurf happy. The idea is to progress through seven simple side-scrolling stages and search for items and food for Baby Smurf. Players will discover objects and are instructed by the game on where and how to use them (The game uses simple instructions and symbols to do this as most 4 year olds can't read.) Each stage progresses in difficulty and includes an option to replay the levels over and over again.

More skilled players will enjoy the second section of the game. Baby Smurf and nine others Smurfs have been kidnaped by the Gorgs, a magical creation of Gargamel. Once again, it is Hefty to the rescue. On his quest to save his fellow Smurfs from their unlucky plight. Hefty interacts with various enemies like the Cracoucass bird and jumps his way through 10 different settings, including a mine, a volcano, a forest and a mountain. To make his endeavors more complicated, Hefty also has to keep an eye on Baby Smurf who appears during key moments of the game.

Even though the second part is a bit more difficult than the first, the challenge level remains fairly low throughout the whole adventure.

The game's appealing presentation and simple gameplay should definitely make it a safe choice for parents or grandparents looking for suitable entertainment for younger Play Station owners.

Editor's Desk.....

If you all will refer back to Newsletter #53, we would like to call your attention to the listing for Ice Hockey Smurf #20032. You will find this in the section entitled "PRODUCTION HISTORY."

We neglected to explain the description of Smurf #20032 and, since you will be seeing more items of this nature in the future, we feel the explanation should be given at this time.

20032 Ice Hockey

Schleich DESIGNED 1978

6120 Wallace Berrie Issue 1979 U.S. Market Only

Please note that the word "DESIGNED" has been used (instead of "Issued").

The reason for the use of the word "designed" rather than "issued" is that, although Schleich designs each and every figurine a figurine designed by Schleich is not destined, necessarily to be issued as one of their individual 2" figurines.

In this instance, Schleich **DESIGNED** the Ice Hockey Smurf but **ISSUED** it only as their Super Smurf #40505, Ice Hockey. It never became part of their Line of individual 2" figurines for the European Market.

Wallace Berrie produced Ice Hockey Smurf in Hong Kong as part of their line of individual 2" Smurf figurines. This is the explanation for the "U.S. Market Only" statement.

Remember: Keep this information in mind as similar situations will come up, as we continue with our **Production History Section** in future S.C.C.I. Newsletters.





This has a navy blue helmet, with red and navy blue uniform and white details.






B I P Holland Produces Five New Candy Toppers for 1999 Featuring Baby Smurf

Below are the new Candy Toppers that have proven to be popular with our collectors. As the previous Candy Toppers we have featured, these are approximately 4" in height.

Number one is Baby Smurf in pink outfit sitting on top of a Yellow Half Moon on a blue base. The half moon is ever so delightful with a face! Baby Smurf is waving.



Number two is Baby Smurf in pink outfit sitting on a yellow duck. The duck is on green and yellow base appearing to be water. Baby is holding onto the ducks neck.



Number three is Baby Smurf in pink outfit sitting atop a green base. The block are blue and red.



Number four is Baby Smurf in pink outfit with a brown/orange Teddy Bear on it's lap, sitting on a pink blanket atop a green base.



Number five is Baby Smurf in pink outfit sitting in a blue Log Car. The wheels are black and silver with a silver horn. Baby is holding onto the horn appearing to be honking it.



SCHONWALD PROMOTIONAL SMURF-A-GRAMS

These delightful Smurf-A-Grams are considerably new as noted by the figurines being used. There have been five different figurines used to date, with a sixth due out this winter.

"SCHONWALD TOP OF THE BLACK FOREST"

The Black Forest is a mountain district in southwestern Germany, covered with forests of dark fir and spruce trees. The German name of the region is SCHWARZWALD, which means black forest. The Rhine River flows for almost 100 miles past the western edge of the forest.

The region is noted for its mineral springs. Many health resorts are located near these springs.

The Black Forest is the scene of many ancient German legends and fairy tales. A part of Mark Twains humorous book, "A TRAMP ABROAD," describes the Black Forest.









Of special interest is the Schonwald Smurf-A-Gram featured below. It is signed by Christof Duffner, a World Champion ski jumper as well as a 1994 Olympic Games winner.



The information provided to us on these Smurf-A-Grams is as follows:

The first issue was the "St. Patrick" Smurf in September 1998. It was limited to 180 pieces.

The second and third issued were "Snowboarder Smurf" and "Snowboarder Smurfette" released in November 1998. They were limited to 250 pieces each.

The fourth issued was the Special addition "Nameplate Smurf" with "Christof Duffner" autograph. released in April 1999. This was not limited to any edition size.

The fifth issued was the "Tourist Smurf" released in July 1999. They are limited to 400 pieces.

The sixth is due to be released in the Fall or Winter of 1999/2000.






